for the whole of the Calderdale District.

I married David who, at the time, was with the Duke of Wellington's Regiment doing National Service in the Education Corps. He had attended Leeds University doing a teaching degree. He had several teaching posts ending up at Blackwood Hall Primary as headmaster. It was a beautiful country school. We had two beautiful daughters who also live here in Australia - Lynne in Brisbane and Karen here in Angle Vale. We came here and bought a beautiful 1903 cottage in Freeling. We brought it back to its former glory inside and out. I lost David in 2003 and found I couldn't manage the huge garden so moved to Evanston where I am now with my two rescue dogs . 
The 2021 Gawler Show has been moved to Saturday 20th and Sunday 21st November 2021.
